Unpacking and checking

Remove the product from the packaging and check for damage. If this is the case, do not use it and contact your dealer. Make sure that children do not play with the packaging. They can get caught in it while playing and suffocate.

Storage

Store the product in a clean, dry place away from light. Keep it away from sources of heat and ignition.

Disposal

This article contains alkaline manganese button cell batteries. Batteries must not be disposed of in household waste. You are legally obliged to return used batteries.
